BEHAVIOUR IN HALL

Those dining in Hall should note the 'Code of Practice for Dinner in College Hall' reproduced below.

The *Code of Practice* makes provision for the Buttery staff to refuse access to Hall or to secure the ejection of diners who are obviously intoxicated, whose behaviour is deemed detrimental to the maintenance of proper order or who are otherwise in flagrant breach of the Code of Practice.

In order to ensure that dining in Hall is a pleasant experience for all, we have instructed the Head of Buttery to observe the following procedure for dealing with behaviour that fails to meet the standards set by the *Code of Practice*.

- 1. Those responsible for misbehaviour will first be asked by the Head of Catering or those deputising to desist and will be given a verbal warning.
- 2. If the misbehaviour persists, the Head of Catering or those deputising may request a College porter to eject from Hall those responsible, whose names will be recorded in the 'Hall Incident Book' and reported to the Dean. The consequences may include a ban on dining in Hall for up to a term. In the event of a porter being unavailable, the Head of Catering or those deputising may eject those responsible from Hall.
