John L. Goulandris Scholarship 2021

The family of John L. Goulandris have provided a generous benefaction to support a Scholarship for Greek nationals who have demonstrated academic excellence, are normally under the age of 35, and are ordinarily resident in Greece (Hellenic Republic). One scholarship will be offered to an offer holder at the University for a one-year taught Masters or a three year research degree leading to a PhD. There is no restriction in the field of study.

The scholarship will provide up to £12,000 per year towards fees depending on the programme length, and satisfactory annual progress reports. Applicants are expected to apply for other sources of funding and the Goulandris award will be adjusted to take other funds received into consideration.

The offer holder will be selected by Magdalene College. It is a condition of the award that the recipient be a member of Magdalene College or willing to transfer to Magdalene College.

It is expected that all applicants will have been made an offer by the University before the scholarship application deadline of 13 March 2021 (12 noon UK time).

Applicants should apply by uploading this application form together with your supporting materials via the Magdalene College upload portal at <https://www.magd.cam.ac.uk/document-upload> or by post to the Academic Office, Magdalene College, Cambridge CB3 0AG, to arrive no later than 13 March 2021 (12 noon UK time). You also need to arrange for two recent academic references to be supplied by the competition deadline using the form at the end of this document, which should be passed on to your academic referees. The references should be written by people who can offer an assessment of your academic achievements, your broader interests, and your potential to contribute to the advancement of your field of study in the long term.

Please ensure that all the required application paperwork is submitted as early as possible. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
